

A Note from Your Pastor

Dear Calvary Church,

he date was February 1, 2022 and the time was 6:32 PM. I was reading Mark 4 when I received a text from Tim & Julie Nelson, asking, "Do you have time for a phone call this evening?" When Tim called, he simply asked,

"DO YOU HAVE ANY reservations about living in MN?"

He told me about Calvary and the process of praying began.

THERE WE WERE IN GARLAND, TX, living the life God had given us there. Minnesota was not on our radar. In fairness, no "location" was on our radar. We only wanted to be God's will, regardless of any location.

WE DID NOT KNOW at that moment God would call us to Calvary Church, New Prague. God did! By July His will for us was very clear and in August we packed up our lives, all our belongings, said good-bye to family and friends, and moved to MN.

WC DID NOT KNOW anyone here. We were uneducated about living in the cold north, blizzards and snow-blowers. I'll never forget our first big lesson: do not snowblow your driveway until AFTER the plow truck plows your street. Yeah, we learned that one the hard way. So, after purchasing a lot of real winter gear and discovering many things that were not on the radar of our knowledge and experience, we made it through that first winter.

YET, THERE Was one THING WE KNEW FOR CERTAIN and it overshadowed everything we did not know:

GOD CALLED US TO CALVARY CHURCH IN NEW PRABUE, MN!

We were exactly where He wanted us geographically, relationally and pastorally. We would soon discover that in the sometimes frozen land of Shakopee and New Prague, there were many warm hearts. God gave us new, life-long friends. He brought several people to salvation and moved several others into an exciting love of Him through his Word.

EVERY WECK PEOPLE COME TO ME WITH SCATITUDE, desires to learn more about the text and joy from the deepening of their own walk with Christ. We've walked with many through happy times and others through difficult times. We have shared life with so many of you. We have been so blessed!

THERE WE WERE, ONCE ABOUND, enjoying the life God had given us, when God decided to interrupt it. Being happy someplace is great, but

Being in his will, wherever that may lead, whatever that may involve, is paramount.

Like last time, God's call out of our current location, set of friends and all things familiar to us, came as a surprise.

WE WE'TE NOT EXPECTINE IT. Though we have not, yet, arrived in our new location and church, nor have we gained a new set of friends, we are confident God will provide. He always has! Think about it: There are people in AZ who are presently unknown to us and us them, who are already friends according to God's plan. We just don't know each other, yet.

IT Has Been Both a Joyous and Difficult Time since My resignation to calvary. Our hearts are heavy at the thought of not seeing you each week. You, however, are never out of reach. We are leaving a geographic location, but not friendships. We are leaving this local church, but not our Calvary family. We love you and are so glad that God called us here! I am so proud and grateful to have been your pastor and fellow servant for the time God designated.



Dear Church,


As a Missions Team, we've been reflecting on the last part of 2024 and are filled with gratitude with how our church has joined in reaching our community and beyond with the love of Jesus.

We saw this church provide for 35 school-aged kids in foster care as they returned to school and again to 33 foster kids with Christmas presents (newborn to 18yrs old).

You gave \$800 to the State Missions Offering (through the MN/WI Baptist Association), part of which funds the Disaster Relief ministry and sent teams to Cook, MN (flooding relief) and Sikeston, MO (tornado relief).

We also wanted to say "thank you" to those who have been giving to the Benevolence and Lottie Moon Christmas offering. In the last few months, we've been able to help with multiple car repairs and provided groceries and gas through the Benevolence fund.

The Lottie Moon Christmas offering goes to Baptist missionaries and ministries overseas. If this is something you feel led to give to, we'll be collecting for the offering through the end of December.



Looking ahead to the coming months, we're excited for what God can do through the Honduras Missions Trip (March 22-30, 2025) in the Lago Yojoa area, which will be highlighted at our **Missions Festival on Sunday, January 26th.** We're excited to invite you to come and see what we'll be doing, how you can be praying for our Honduras Team, and enjoy some refreshments after the service.

After the Missions Festival, we'll be promoting the **Annie Armstrong Easter offering**, which goes to support Baptist missionaries and ministries all over North America.

IT'S WINTER! HOW COLD IS TOO COLD?

Inclement Weather Policy

The safety of our congregation is a primary concern. Weather conditions maybe different, more, or less severe, depending on where one lives in relation to New Prague, where Calvary Church is located. Each family and individual should make his or her best judgment when deciding whether to make the drive to church or a church event.

The intent of this policy is to ensure the safety of Calvary Church guests, members, volunteers, and staff, as well as to provide effective communications concerning ministries



and activities during severe or hazardous weather, or other emergency situations, such as power outages.

Calvary Church Elders will inform the staff of cancellations, so that the staff can expeditiously implement the necessary communication to Calvary Church. The following tools will be utilized to inform Calvary Church of such cancellations: website announcement, Facebook post, email, and text distributions.



Cancellation Guidelines:

- 1. For events during the week, when school is usually in session, Calvary Church will follow the decision of the New Prague Area Schools.
- a. If the school district cancels evening activities, Calvary Church will cancel their evening activities.
- b. If the district delays start times or cancels only the daytime schedule and keeps the evening activities, Calvary Church will cancel any daytime activities, but keep evening activities intact. (This will require a staff member monitoring the school district's plans.)
- 2. When school is not in session, the following guidelines have been determined by the Calvary Church Elders for the cancellation of church meetings and events:
- a. When the temperature, whether actual or wind chill, is or is forecast to be negative 30 degrees or lower immediately prior to, during, or immediately after the meeting or event.
 - i. Should this occur on a Sunday, the Bible & Life hour and all Calvary Kids programs will be cancelled. Worship services will continue as planned.
- b. When fresh snow accumulation exceeds 5 inches or is forecast to exceed 5 inches, immediately prior to, during, or immediately after the meeting or event.

c. When ice is forecast, or already present, that will make travel hazardous immediately prior to, during, or immediately after the meeting or event.

An Important Note:

There may be times when a cancellation is implemented due to a severe forecast, and the actual weather is not as severe as forecasted.

The Elders would rather make a weather safety decision that turns out to be unnecessary, than put people in danger due to last-minute decisions.


